



47 City and Other Government Councils Endorse U.S. Department of Peacebuilding Legislation

Forty-seven city councils/commissions, including Los Angeles, Chicago, Atlanta and Detroit, plus six county boards of supervisors and one tribal council have passed resolutions or proclamations endorsing/ supporting legislation to establish a U.S. Department of Peacebuilding. All told, these local governing bodies represent populations of nearly **17.7 million people**.
