#### 3. Addressing Systemic Injustice as the Root of Conflict

Why it matters: Peace is not merely the absence of violence; it's the presence of equity, dignity, and opportunity for all. Addressing systemic issues is vital.

#### 4. Bold, Local Actions Lead to Global Impact

Why it matters: Peace starts locally—within individuals, families, and communities—and ripples outward to create global change.

#### 5. Celebrating Courage, Resilience, and Collaboration

Why it matters: Badass Peacebuilding thrives on courage, creativity, and collaboration. It's about showing up, speaking truth to power, and building alliances to create lasting change.

These discussion points bring together the principles of a **Culture of Peace** and the spirit of **Badass Peacebuilding**—action-driven, inclusive, and rooted in justice. By amplifying bold, local voices and addressing systemic challenges, we create a world where peace isn't just possible—it's unstoppable.
