# We need you to AMPLIFY peacebuilding!

**There is a bill in Congress to create a cabinet-level Department of Peacebuilding** (DoP/ HR 1111). It addresses the interconnection of all life and the intersectionality of peace, justice, equality, human rights, governments based upon rule of law and planetary survival.

*It's time to make peacebuilding a national priority* by proactively addressing the root causes of violence and implementing the root conditions of peace with proven and sustainable peacebuilding policies and practices. A DoP will save lives and money. It is our future. **Peace is possible if we work for it. Peace is possible if we build bridges.** 

<u>On May 8 -10, 2023, please AMPLIFY our Voices while we are in DC</u> by phoning the list of Congressmembers below and by contacting your own Member of Congress. Let them know you support HR 1111, the Department of Peacebuilding Act by Rep. Barbara Lee. <u>From May 11 -</u> July 31, 2023, please make more calls to AMPLIFY additional and follow-up contacts with Members of Congress.

### WORK to create a cabinet-level Department of Peacebuilding.

Each call takes only moments. You don't have to be an expert -- just speak from your heart.

### During May - August 2023, we need your help as we:

- Advocate in DC from May 8-10, 2023
- Celebrate Mother's Day as Julia Ward Howe's call for a day of peace with the DoP's ask to members of Congress to give peace a piece of the Federal budget
- Follow up on connections with members of Congress we have been contacting all year and during Spring Advocacy Days in DC

### What you can do:

- See the list below of Congressmembers to contact -- Call 1, 2 or as many as you can.
- Call on May 8-10, 2023. Call again from May 11 July 31, 2023.

#### What to say when you call

Ask to speak with the Legislative Director or a Legislative Assistant. It they aren't available, ask that your message be passed on to a legislative staffer. If you're contacting your own member of Congress, let the person who answers the phone that you are constituent. Then say what is near and dear to your heart about violence and peace and the importance of a DoP. **Ask the Congressmember to cosponsor HR 1111.** The person on the other end of the phone will be taking notes, so it is best to be brief and heartfelt. Thank the staffer.

#### You Make a Difference with your calls and emails

Each communication is counted and reported. Calls are harder to ignore than a full email inbox and lets the Congressmember know that people care about the issue. *If you call a member on our list, you truly add to the impact of our visit.*
