We need you to AMPLIFY peacebuilding!

There is a bill in Congress to create a cabinet-level Department of Peacebuilding (DoP/ HR 1111). It addresses the interconnection of all life and the intersectionality of peace, justice, equality, human rights, governments based upon rule of law, planetary survival and more.

It's time to make peacebuilding a national priority by proactively addressing the root causes of violence and implementing the root conditions of peace with proven and sustainable peacebuilding policies and practices. A DoP will save lives and money. It is transformative and will make history. It is our future. Peace is possible if we work for it. Peace is possible if we build bridges.

What to say when you call

Ask to speak with the Legislative Director or a Legislative Assistant. It they aren't available, ask that your message be passed on to a legislative staffer. If you're contacting your own member of Congress, let the person who answers the phone that you are constituent. Then say what is near and dear to your heart about violence prevention, peace and the importance of a DoP. Ask the Congressmember to cosponsor HR 1111 by contacting Rep. Barbara Lee's office (Adriana.rivera@mail.house.gov or 212-225-2661). The person on the other end of the phone will be taking notes, so it is best to be brief and heartfelt. Thank the staffer.
